- 1. Proof of their and any other household member's social security, SSI disability, retirement, pension or other forms of income.
- 2. A copy of the solid waste account holder's driver's license or picture identification.
- 3. <u>Three</u> consecutive months of each household member's checking and/or savings account statement.
- 4. The original notarized 2026 Washington County Solid Waste Exemption Affidavit and Application.
- 5. Completed Washington County Solid Waste Questionnaire.

All completed applications along with all accompanying documentation must be submitted in original form to the Washington County Solid Waste Disposal Authority located at 25 Court Street, Chatom, Alabama or by mail to the following address:

All applications must be received in the Solid Waste office or postmarked no later than Wednesday, November 30, 2025. No exceptions will be allowed.
